- **Community Mobility**
 - **Moving self in the community and using public or private transportation, such as driving, or accessing buses, taxi cabs, or other public transportation systems**

(AOTA Practice Framework, 2002, p. 620)

 - **Allows for engagement in other areas of occupation**

- **Self-screening**
 - **UMTRI Decision Guide**
 - **AAA Roadwise Review**
 - **Checklists and booklets**
- **Professional screening & referral**
 - **Law Enforcement & DMV**
 - **Physicians**
 - **SW, OT, etc. Screen and refer**



The Role Of Generalist & Specialist

- **All occupational therapists can**
 - Identify and treat impairments impacting function
 - Refer to specialists to assess driving competence
- **Demographic changes are driving practice to address changes associated with aging, medical conditions and co-morbidities**
 - Identify red flags for driving risk
 - educational resources and initiatives
 - For practitioners
 - For involvement in community initiatives



The Occupational Therapy Driver Rehabilitation Specialist

- Specialists have advanced education in driver evaluation, instruction and training, adaptive equipment & vehicle modification
- Evaluation of individual strengths and limitations
 - Clinical & on-road portions
(ADED Best Practices 2005 & AOTA Older Driver Practice Guideline, 2006)
- Outcome of a driving evaluation
 - Intervention to address impairment
 - Is not just “thumbs up or thumbs down”



Driving Evaluation: Basic Physical Assessment

- **Physical assessment:**
 - Strength
 - Balance
 - Endurance
 - Range of Motion
 - Sensation
 - Reaction time
- **Visual Assessment**
 - Visual acuity
 - Contrast Sensitivity
 - Color perception
 - Depth perception
 - Visual fields
 - Visual scanning



Driving Evaluation: Cognitive Assessment

- MMSE
- Short Blessed
- Speed of processing
- Useful Field of View
- Multitasking assessment
- Driving performance assessments
- Simulators
- Psychosocial Assessment
 - Depression
 - Pain



Driving Evaluation: On Road Performance

- On-road or Behind-the-wheel evaluation
 - Predriving routines checklist
 - Driving in various situations
 - Driver characteristics and behaviors
 - Performance in context
- Fixed route vs. variable route
 - Pros and cons

Outcome of a Driving Evaluation

- Recommend intervention ...to continue driving
 - Lessons & training, strategies
 - Recommend restrictions
 - Adaptation and compensation
 - Time to recover, re-evaluate
- Recommend cessation ...when risk too high
 - Identify appropriate alternatives
 - Caregiver training



NHTSA's Law Enforcement Module

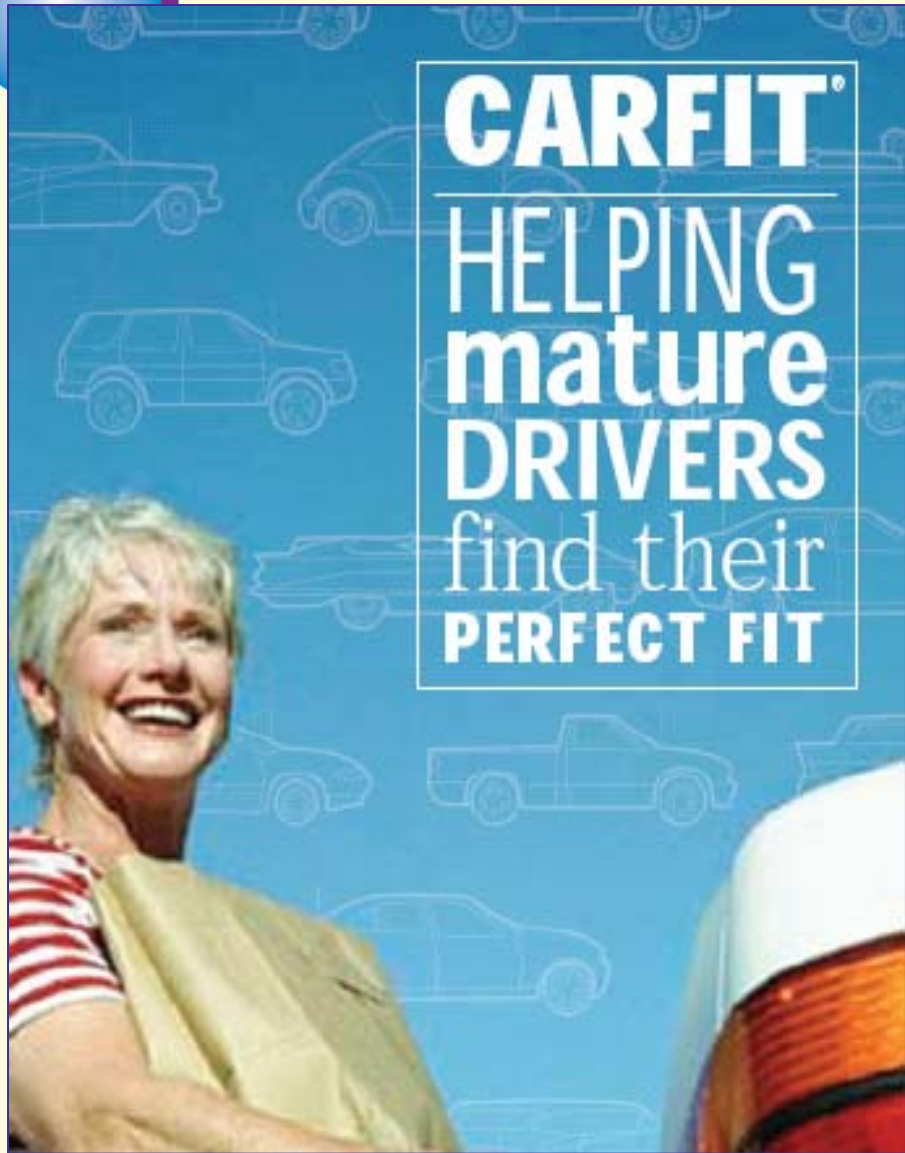

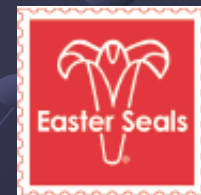

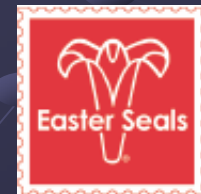
- Targeting caregivers, volunteer transportation programs and other transportation options to support older adults and their caregivers

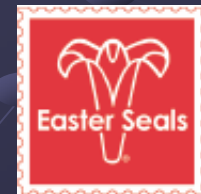

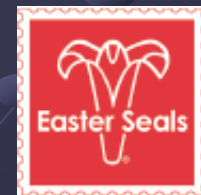

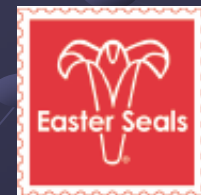

 - Placement
 - Adjustment
- **Risk and liability**

 - **Primary Goal: to drive safer longer**
 - **Cessation: Address client and caregiver needs**
- **Invite occupational therapists and demand program development**
