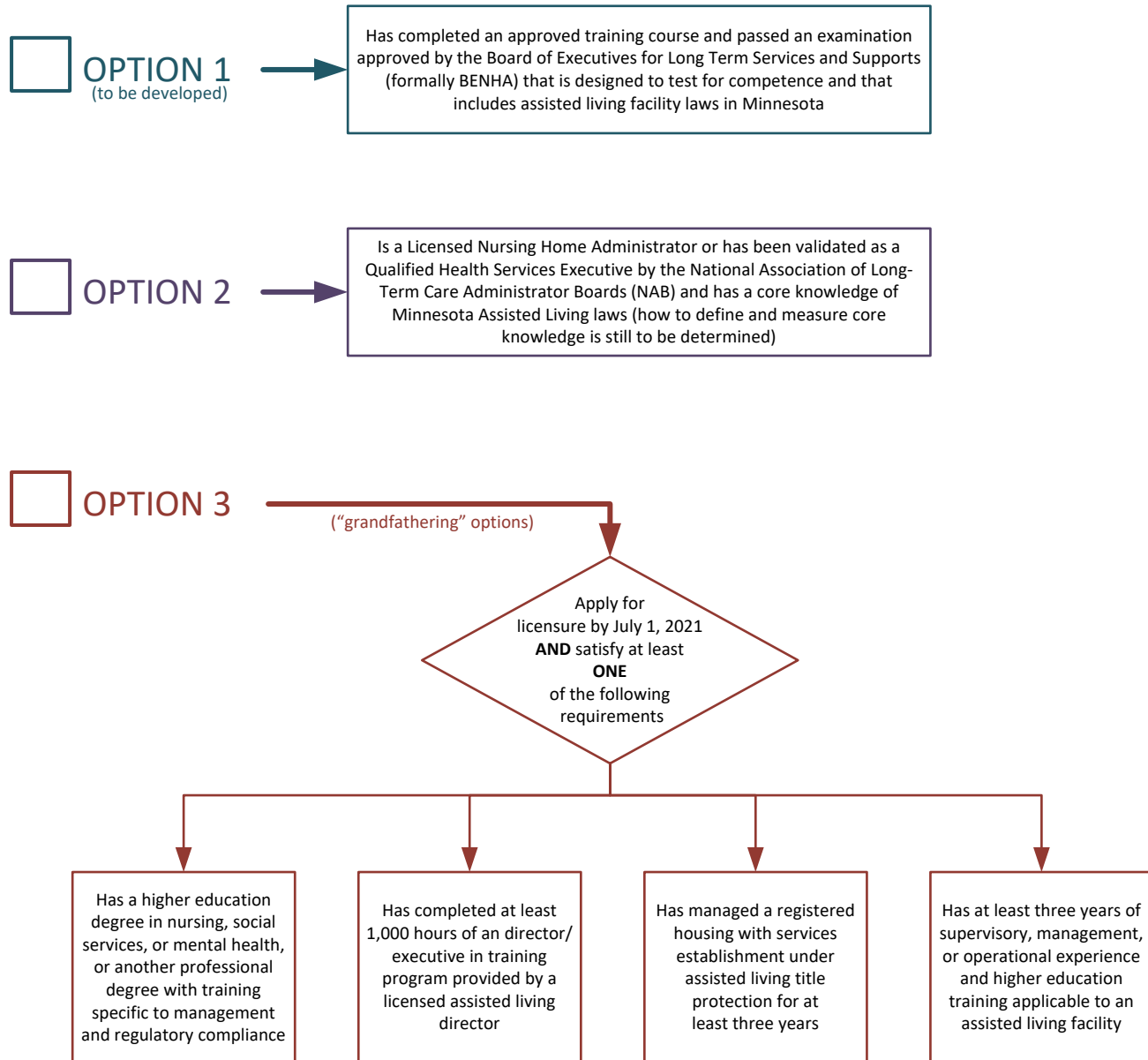


## Assisted Living Director Licensure

By August 1, 2021, each Licensed Assisted Living Facility in Minnesota must be managed by a Licensed Assisted Living Director. There are three “routes” available to become a Licensed Assisted Living Director:



Assisted Living Director licenses will be managed by the Minnesota Board of Executives for Long Term Services and Supports (formerly the Board of Examiners for Nursing Home Administrators/BENHA).

Each Licensed Assisted Living Director must receive at least 30 hours of training every two years on topics relevant to the operation of a Licensed Assisted Living Facility and the needs to its residents. If the Licensed Assisted Living Director is managing a Licensed Assisted Living with *Dementia Care*, the Director must complete and document that at least 10 hours of the required 30 hours of training relate to the care of individuals with dementia.
